**Rules & Conditions of Play**

1. The SRFI rules shall apply unless otherwise stated. Players should note the code of conduct and abide by its regulations.
2. **A player can enter only one category.**
3. A minimum of 8 entries is required to conduct the tournament in any category. In case of inadequate entries in any category, the SRFI observer's decision will be final and binding.
4. Local players may be required to play their first match from 14<sup>th</sup> December onwards. There may also be an alternative venue, in the event there are a large number of entries.
5. There will be a play off for the top 8 positions in the Men's, Women's and Professional categories. Players will be required to play until the last day.
6. Players participating in the 'Masters category' must be within their age category as on **15<sup>th</sup> December 2009. All players are requested to carry documentary proof of age (Passport or Birth Certificate).** In the event of any doubt, the SRFI Observer has the right to order a medical test on the player.
7. \*A 'Professional' is a person who earns his livelihood from squash coaching and is employed full time by a club / institution.
8. **Disciplinary action may be taken against players who without valid reason give a walkover or do not turn up for the event.**
9. Matches shall be a best of 5 games with an 11 point-a-rally scoring system.
10. Copies of the draws and each day's match schedule shall be posted on the notice boards.
11. Players are required to report to the tournament office at least 20 minutes before the scheduled time of their match. Failure to do so may result in a walk over.
12. The tournament committee shall arrange referees for the matches. However players may be requested to referee matches and if so requested, are obliged to do so. The organisers will provide squash balls for the matches.
13. Players must wear shoes with non-marking soles.
14. Players should make themselves available to meet reasonable requests for interviews by the media with the concurrence of the SRFI. However, players should not air their opinions on controversial issues or make any derogatory remarks about participants, officials, referees or any related parties.
15. Severe disciplinary action will be taken against players who abuse (verbal or gesture) referees/officials on or off court throughout the duration of the championship - This may include suspension from participation in SRFI sanctioned events.
16. In the event of disputes, the decision of the SRFI observer shall be final and binding.
17. Accommodation or TA/DA will not be provided. In the event the government releases the funds for the championship, TA/DA will be sent to the players directly.
18. Each participant (apart from Professionals) will pay an entry fee of Rs.250/- to The Squash Rackets Federation of India. A consolidated demand draft of the entry fee must be sent by each affiliated state associations / associate members payable to the 'Squash Rackets Federation of India' at the time of sending the entry.
19. Entries must be sent to the Squash Rackets Federation of India only through the affiliated state associations of the Federation. **No direct individual entries will be accepted.** States who are not affiliated to the SRFI but have Associate members under section 9 (b) of the Constitution viz. Clubs, Schools, Colleges, or other organizations not specified can send entries directly to the Federation.
